Enjoy a **breathtaking view** of the Brest harbor aboard the cable car! France's first urban cable car connects lower Siam (city center) directly to Les Ateliers des Capucins.

The **magic of Les Ateliers des Capucins** lies in this monumental 19th-century venue, which will provide an **incredible background** for your event.

A **1500sqm space** will be reserved for you to organize your cocktail and dinner in the heart of Les Ateliers des Capucins directly next to the old machines, close to the Emperor's boat and the Ocean gallery, 70.8

Docked along the Penfeld in 1814, the Emperor's Boat was rerouted to Paris in 1943 to preserve it from potential war damage.

For nearly 130 years, this Napoleonic vessel thus resided in Brest and undeniably became part of Brest's heritage. After 72 years of absence, the Emperor's Boat returned to its home port in Brest at the end of 2019.

A symbolic return to the heart of the Capucins Workshops, restoring to the place a significant maritime essence.

Participants will feel the privilege of enjoying a cocktail near this historic monument.

Access to Les Ateliers via cable car from the city center

What could be a more beautiful way to land at your gala evening than by overlooking the harbor of Brest?

Since the participants' hotels are mostly located in Brest's city center, congress participants will only need to walk or take the tram to reach the cable car station for their Gala evening.
